

# The Chestnut Hill School

## Program Eligibility for Financial Aid For academic year 2010-2011

Financial assistance is available to Chestnut Hill School families for tuition, as well as the variety of enrichment programs offered at the school. Below please find a summary of the different programs for which aid is available, as well as guidelines for obtaining financial aid. Please keep in mind, most financial aid discounts are determined by the "other eligible programs" aid rate listed on your financial aid award letter. This rate will apply to many tuition-charging programs, except where noted below. To find out your child's aid rate, please refer to your 2010-2011 financial aid award letter.

### TUITION PROGRAMS

Program	Aid	How Awarded
<b>Afterschool and Discovery Programs</b>	Available to families where all custodial guardians work.  Calculated at the "other eligible programs" aid rate*	Automatically applied.
<b>Other Afterschool Programs –</b> karate, rock band, ice skating, etc.	Aid is not available	N/A
<b>Afterschool Drop-In Charges</b>	Aid is not available	N/A
<b>Chestnut Hill School for Music</b>	Aid is offered on 1 series of lessons per semester per child. It is calculated at the "other eligible programs"* aid rate up to a maximum of 50%.  Should one program or lesson <i>require</i> the taking of a second program or lesson, the aid will be calculated on both.  The registration fee is not eligible for aid.	Automatically applied, but the full registration fee and adjusted amount due must be included with registration. Your child will not be registered without it.
<b>Vacation Camps</b>	Aid is available when all custodial guardians work.  Calculated at the "other eligible programs" aid rate.*	Automatically applied, but the adjusted amount due must be included with registration. Your child will not be registered without it.
<b>Chestnut Hill School Creative Arts and Sports Program</b>	Aid is available when all custodial guardians work.  Calculated at the 10/11 "other eligible programs" aid rate* for summer 2011.	Automatically applied.  The adjusted deposit must be sent in when registering. Your child will not be registered without it.  It is not available for siblings not receiving aid at CHS.

<b>Carnival</b>	Free admission for student, parent(s) and minor siblings.  1 free meal ticket for each person attending. Please check the <i>Bill to Account</i> option at admissions – the proper credit will be applied and you will be billed for any charges above those listed.
<b>Book Fair</b>	A \$20 credit for books they purchase from the CHS Book Fair(s).	Option 1: Please check the <i>CHS account up to \$20</i> box. You will be billed for any purchases over \$20. (any child may check this box to have they family billed for books they purchase)  Option 2: Submit a copy of your payment and your child’s account will be credited for up to \$20.

<b>Class Photo Day</b>	Package E is available at no cost to families that would like assistance with purchasing student photos.	Please send Laura at <a href="mailto:lrutherford@tchs.org">lrutherford@tchs.org</a> with your child(s) name and grade prior to the Class Photo Day. You will be sent Package E (they select the best picture). You will receive a password also from them in case you want to order more pictures.
